



Spring 2020 workshop IN SAN CLEMENTE'S GARDEN 30 March - 3 April 2020

Introduction

The workshop "In San Clemente's Garden" continues the long-time collaboration between Kent State University Florence, College of Architecture & Environmental Design and DIDA, Dipartimento di Architettura dell'Università degli Studi di Firenze. Previous experiences have seen students engaged in architecture workshops and studios focused on the reconstruction of the urban fabric in small Tuscan historical centers: Bientina (2008), San Miniato (2011), Magliano in Toscana (2017 and 2018) and Florence (2018).

Theme

Theme of the project is the design of a medium sized pavilion to be installed in the garden of San Clemente as a facility for the School of Architecture and its library. The functional core of the intervention will be the exhibition space dedicated to the presentation of students' and professors' architectural projects. A

literary café and a room for collective activities - meetings, book presentations, conferences - complement the requested program.
